Yes, NATO HQ SACT will consider existing and under developed concepts or products that are currently not authorized by FedRamp. Federal Risk and Authorization Management Program (FedRAMP) is a US government-wide program that provides a standardized approach to security assessment, authorization, and continuous monitoring for cloud products and services. FedRAMP empowers agencies to use modern cloud technologies, with emphasis on security and protection of federal information, and helps accelerate the adoption of secure, cloud solutions. If we only consider FedRAMP approved/authorized providers, we might limit our opportunities and exclude some potential contributors. |
