The Table of Contents is provided as a guideline to ensure the documents listed are included in the proposal.</p> <p>b. Bidders information & compliance statement should be included in the Technical proposal.</p> <p>c. Yes, past performance and key personnel should be included in the Technical proposal.</p>
<p>2. Please explain the full contents required for the single price proposal file.</p> <p>a. Is there a table of contents specific to this volume or the one that is for the entire proposal?</p> <p>b. Is the order a cover, table of contents, Enclosure 4, Enclosure 5 and a narrative?</p> <p>c. Is a narrative required to support the pricing and confirm requirements of the IFB were incorporated?</p>	<p>a.
