

Fact Sheet – Future Land Command and Control

Background: Land Command and Control (Land C2) is a focus of capability development in ACT. Capability development aims to enhance Allied Commander's ability to plan, execute, and assess NATO land operations. In doing this, the program will focus on establishing state-of-the art command and control decision making that leverages advances in procedures, organisations, and technology. Therefore, Program activities will draw from experience, envision future needs, and provide mechanisms that will deliver adaptive, intelligent, and effective capabilities.

In 2019, experimentation will support the verification and validation of requirements and the establishment of acceptance criteria, both of which help shape the capability development program. Additionally, experimentation in TRIDENT JUPITER 2019 PART II, STEADFAST JUPITER/JACKAL 2020, and LOYAL LEDA 2020 will enable exploring and evaluating adaptive, intelligent and technology oriented solutions.
