Fact Sheet – Rapid Deployment Inter-Theatre Movement in Europe (RDIM-E)

Background: To improve the deployment of NATO Forces, a review of the Major Joint Operation

Plus (MJO+) deployment models for the next NATO Defence Planning Process (NDPP) cycle is needed. This project will develop the Rapid Deployment Inter-Theatre Movement in Europe (RDIM-E) Concept and subsequently the related doctrine shall be reviewed. In addition, other key capability areas such as Infrastructure, Material and Training, shall be addressed on this project.

Mission: Identify the capabilities (DOTMLPFI) required to produce a rapid, responsive and

near-optimal deployment plan up to MJO+.

Milestones: 1 - Provide recommendations for updating the current Defence Planning

Deployment Models. RDIM-E whitepaper to support the RDIM-E Concept

development.

2 - Define the user and capability requirements for a planning and execution

simulation tool capable of supporting up to a MJO+ Deployment. Inputs for the user

requirement for a Simulation Capability tool

3 - Provide recommendations to meet the strategic lift capability requirements all over the DOTMLPFI spectrum, for the execution of a MJO+. A proof of concept will

be validated in Trident Jupiter 19 if mature enough or in Trident Jupiter 2020
