- Event Overview:** The 2020 International CD&E Conference will take place for the first time in a virtual setting. This event aims to promote a collaborative approach to concept development, and share the knowledge and experience garnered from national expertise. The four-day 2020 ICD&E Conference will encompass a scope from exploring themes for future concepts to applied experimentation as well as creative ideation, additionally offering workshop opportunities to improve individual exposure to CD&E tool and topics. Highlights will include unique and engaging speakers from allied and partner nations, academia and industry, interactive questions and answer sessions, panel discussions, networking opportunities, and the 'CD&E Exchange', a virtual Expo promoting CD&E organizations, work strands, and related initiatives.
- CD&E Exchange:** Adopting the format of a virtual mini-expo, the CD&E Exchange aims to provide an informal environment where conference attendees can network, exchange ideas, and showcase current and future CD&E work.
