Synopsis:	Strengthening Alliance deterrence and defence posture requires the translation of political direction into practical, executable, and adaptive military capability that integrates approaches to deterring both current and emerging threats. Supporting the priority to strengthen the Alliance deterrence and defence posture in the complex 21st Century environment requires persistent capability to recognize and understand threats of state, non-state, and other actors, analyse deterrence potential, support political and military decision-making in a comprehensive environment, assess effectiveness, and recommend adjustments. Through dynamic testing of conceptual solutions, this experiment will support development of a coherent deterrence framework.
Mission:	Validation of a broad-spectrum deterrence assessment methodology developed for NATO by National Strategic Research Institute (NSRI) – University of Nebraska, the USSTRATCOM University Affiliated Research Centre.
