<b>Background:</b>	The <b>Multinational Capability Development Campaign (MCDC)</b> series is an initiative led by the United States designed to collaboratively develop and assess concepts and capabilities to address the challenges associated with conducting joint, multinational and coalition operations.
<b>Capability relevance:</b>	Future Leaders within Defence must be better equipped to operate effectively in the Future Operating Environment, considering challenges such as requirements of working below and above thresholds of armed conflict; the influence of pervasive information & impact of technology; enduring and emerging requirements and the preparation of future Leaders to meet these challenges.
