2020 Fact Sheet – NSHQ Comprehensive Defence Concept - Joint Fires

Background:	As part of the Supreme Allied Commander Europe Comprehensive Defence Concept, the idea of training citizen soldiers, home guard, and territorials in the skill of Forward Observer is critical. This experiment builds upon the virtual reality (VR) training and artificial intelligence (AI) assessment of the Coaching & Mentoring experiment. It proposes a VR Joint Fires (Jt Fires) course delivered in Europe under the control of NATO Special Operations Headquarters to train the increase in Force Elements without the need to send to Fort Sill, CONUS. It will employ a fully immersive training environment and predictive AI to grade the Competence, Capability and Currency of these Force Elements, allowing the control staff to inject themselves into the training scenarios remotely from any location, at any time.
Mission:	Build upon the VR/AI Coaching & Mentoring Experiment to deliver a viable remote/distance learning and assessment capability for Jt Fires Observers.
