Background:	Supreme Allied Commander Transformation (SACT) recently announced that a second experiment cohort of the Professional Doctorate (ProfDoc) would take place to identify if applying the findings from the first cohort would more closely align outputs with the SACT LOE and in doing so identify the relevance of the <i>ProfDoc</i> for development into a permanent programme.
Mission:	A hypothesis experiment to identify if <i>Higher Education Interventions</i> across a period of time can increase the productivity, accuracy, and impact of ACT staff work product. It will also examine if such interventions are found to effectively reduce work currently offset to contractors and that work that will be tasked to contractors is defined and of such an input that it can only be achieved through their use.
