- Background:** There is a lack of a coherent training framework across the Human Security landscape. Topics relating to Human Security are handled differently within development and maintenance of training. There are many cross cutting topic standalone elements being developed. Some have their own discipline, others are under an existing discipline, which has responsibility for a broad range of unrelated topics, and others do not fall under any discipline.
