**Background:** SOF C2 CIS capability programme is intended to provide a new Command and Control

capability to NATO Special Operations Component Command and Special Operations Task Groups, fully interoperable and Federated Mission Network compliant, for the NATO Response Force. SOF C 2 CIS subject matter experts will participate in STEADFAST JUPITER 21 as observers, in order to confront SOF C2 CIS projects against SOF processes and procedures, and so assess if the projects are fit-for-purpose or should be adjusted.

Mission: The experiment assesses SOF C2 CIS projects against SOF processes and procedures as

well as FMN requirements.
