Background:	The project targets advanced training within military operations command and control centers or civilian crisis management centres. ORCHESTRAA aims to provide new teaching methods allowing:	
	to improve training through the use of virtual reality and artificial intelligence (offering a capacity of immersion and the possibility of simulating a greater variety of scenarios, particularly in terms of coordination and interactions between trainees).	
	to reduce the workload and the human resources necessary for the development and conduct of training sessions through intuitive and simplified piloting and management solutions.	
	to overcome the problems of manpower, the AI will be essentially non-scripted and able to adapt to the learning situations desired by the trainers.	
Aim:	ORCHESTRAA Project aims to demonstrate the usefulness of new technologies for operational training in a crisis management room.
