Background:	<p>The Multinational Force Commander requires radically improved cross-national C2 system interoperability to counter peer and near-peer adversary capability. This is characterized by the need for increased:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Allied / Partner investment in capabilities that improve data and information sharing compatibility;• Allied / Partner's investment in capabilities that improve data-centric security of information; and• Allied / Partner's alignment with C2 doctrines / processes / procedures required for unified operations. <p>This project will focus on existing Allied and Partner literature, development and acquisition actions, and doctrinal developments regarding C2 Systems interoperability</p>
Aim:	<p>The deliverable is a Project Report that will describe key principles, initiatives, approaches, and applications that can accelerate implementation of improved joint multinational C2 systems interoperability.</p>
