



NATO Allied Command Transformation **Joint Force Development Experimentation & Wargaming Branch 2023 Fact Sheet – NATO Practitioners Wargaming Course**

- Background:** NATO's strategic commands, with ACT in the lead, were tasked to develop an Analysis and Wargaming capability for NATO. A key aspect of delivering this capability is the formalisation of NATO Wargaming training. The NATO Practitioners Wargaming Course was delivered as a pilot course in 2022.
- Aim:** The course is intended as a practical course on Wargaming in a NATO context. The course aims to emphasise hands-on training. This course is anticipated to be scheduled twice per calendar year at NSO and will accommodate, respectively, per iteration, 25-50 NATO Wargaming Practitioners within the NATO Command Structure (NCS), NATO Force Structure (NFS), or in those National or International positions involving wargaming in multinational joint planning, operations or exercises.
- WDI:** The NATO Practitioners Wargaming Course aligns under Allied Command Transformation Warfare Development Imperative (WDI) – Cross Domain Command.

- Attendees:** The audience for the NATO Practitioners Wargaming Course are officers and NCOs in the NCS/NFS who are involved in the planning and execution of NATO wargaming.
