Management Information System (AMIS) Prototype’s

Capabilities

- Background:** NATO standards and search capabilities in the Ammunition Management Information System Prototype shall give NATO Commanders, Logistics staffs and other users, access and visibility to multiple Allied Joint Publications to support decision-making during planning and execution phases for ammunition management within an Article 5 environment. Key topics are the Identification, Storage, Transportation, Interchangeability, Maintenance, Inspection, Handling, Usage and Explosives Safety as well as Munitions Risk Management. Designated future official web version of Ammunition Management Information System should also provide the information they need for dealing with ammunition in any situation in the theatre. This experiment will be integrated into Exercise LOYAL LEDA 2022.
- Aim:** The activity will support the evaluation of search capabilities in Ammunition Management Information System Prototype to give NATO Commanders, Logistics staffs and other users, access and visibility to multiple Allied Joint Publications to support decision-making during planning and execution phases for ammunition management within an Article 5 environment.
- WDI:** Evaluation of the Ammunition Management Information System prototype’s capabilities aligns under Allied Command Transformation Warfare Development Imperative (WDI) – Cross Domain Command.
