The following questions were raised with respect to subject IFIB. Responses are to provide clarification.

Questions	Responses
1.It is assumed that you are looking for the rate per period to generate the deliverables in Enclosure 3. For some deliverables, the rate would vary depending on the number of Alternatives under investigation. For pricing purposes should we assume there are 10 Alternatives under investigation.	1.Your assumption is correct. For pricing purposes there are ten (10) alternatives under investigation.
2.A company does not comply with the eligibility criteria stated in 4(c) – “Has performed the desired past performance including size, cost and scope, as described in this IFIB” and with the more concrete second mandatory criteria from Annex B. However the team that the company would propose meets and exceeds these criteria from their previous jobs and experiences. It is highly eligible and synchronized team that has performed similar in size, cost and scope projects for NATO, EU and European Space Agency (ESA). My question is: Will a proposal from the behind which stays a fully compliant team make the proposal eligible?	2.
