

In accordance with IFIB-ACT-JFTC 22-26 Bidding Instructions – point 8 please find below the questions and answers. Published answers shall be regarded as the authoritative interpretation of this IFIB.

1	IFIB-ACT-JFTC 22-26 Part I	Paragraph 4	Since we are planning to submit our proposal as a consortium of two companies that have the same ownership (one company registered in NATO member country being the leader of the consortium and one company registered in non-NATO member country being the member of the consortium), please let us know if the "Administrative Proposal" documentation (Volume A) only applies for the leader?	<p>Participation of a consortium of companies in the bidding for IFIB-ACT-JFTC 22-26 is possible however the constituent companies have to meet <u>individually</u> the eligibility criteria defined in the IFIB-ACT-JFTC 22-26 Part I, Point 4, unless the consortium is organised as a separate company with a distinct legal identity in a NATO member country.</p> <p>Bidder must submit Volume A including all required by this IFIB documents separately for each company being constituent of the consortium unless the consortium is organised as a separate company with a distinct legal identity in a NATO member country.</p>
2	General	General	Please confirm if the civil liability insurance policy of the leader of the consortium is accepted?	Civil liability insurance must be sent separately for each company being constituent of the consortium unless the consortium is organised as a separate company with a distinct legal identity in a NATO member country.

3	IFIB-ACT-JFTC 22-26 Part III	SOW, Paragraph 3.b.	Are local civilian hires authorised to purchase non rationed items with local taxes from the canteen? If not, could this be considered in future?	Only personnel listed in IFIB-ACT-JFTC 22-26 Part III, Paragraph 3.b. are entitled to purchase goods at JFTC Canteen. Extension of eligibility to other groups of personnel can be done only through a change of international agreements between Poland and NATO and then amended through Polish legislation. There are no plans to make such a change of agreements and legislation.

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
