The following questions were raised with respect to subject IFIB. Responses are to provide clarification.

Questions	Responses
1. Can ACT clarify what is the maximum amount of profiles that the bidders can submit with their response?	Bidders can only submit one profile/candidate with their response.
2. Can ACT clarify that the following statement pertains to this IFIB: "HQ SACT reserves the right to charge to the Contractor any additional cost of HQ SACT inspection and test when supplies are not ready at the time such inspection, when test is requested by Contractor or when re-inspection or retest is necessitated by prior rejection."	HQ SACT GENERAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS are general and used for all our contracts.
3. Can ACT clarify if replacement candidates will be accepted in case of unavailability of the approved resources and if so, under what conditions?	If initially awarded contract and that candidate is unavailable, the next bidder in line will receive an opportunity to execute the contract. If a bidder receives the award, and during the timeframe of the contract the candidate can no longer provide their services, HQ SACT P&C will seek the bidder to provide a replacement that meets the standards required within the IFIB. Pre-approval will be required by P&C prior to accepting replacement candidate.
4. Can ACT clarify what will be the accepted Notice Period in case of unavailability of the approved resources and what will be the Terms and Conditions?	Deadline for proposals is 15DEC21. A CAC board will be conducted shortly thereafter to identify the awarded bidder. Planned notification will be immediate upon the execution of the CAC board. Expectation is the candidate is available to work at the start of January 2022.
