

IFIB: IFIB-ACT-SACT-22-16 AIR DUCT CLEANING

The following questions were raised with respect to subject IFIB. Responses are to provide clarification.

Questions	Responses
1. NATO stated that they can calculate the SF by floor of ducting per drawings. Can NATO please provide this calculated square footage number? This will assist in generating an accurate number and price per square foot for pricing requirements.	NATO provided you the drawings for all of the HVAC systems for our facility. Please use these drawings to calculate the square footage to ensure complete accuracy.
2. Is the contractor to hold any bonds for this contract?	NATO is currently updating the bond provisions under the terms and conditions.
3. During the initial site visit, it was mentioned that a single man lift may be provided for contractors to use. Please confirm if NATO is willing to provide this lift.	NATO will not furnish equipment of any type.
4. Being that no PEDs are permitted inside the building; is there a point of contact/ emergency hotline that families can call in case of emergencies to get a hold of workers inside the building?	Yes, there will be a POC provided.
5. Some work will require more than one location/ area being worked on at once, at different floors of the building. For communication purposes, will hand held walkie-talkies be allowed to use to facilitate worksite safety communication; or is this still considered a PED?	Currently walkie-talkies are prohibited for everyone including our staff. A recommended approach would be to use desk phones to call each other as needed. Desk phones also have speakerphone options if needed.
