Ultimately a NATO SECRET clearance is the requirement; however we will accept an active NATO or National SECRET clearance for bidding purposes as the national clearance can be converted to a NATO clearance quite easily post award.
re: 450 Hours - Base Years / 1800 Hours) We typically review proposals that indicate more hours (e.g., 2080).	The basis of this calculation is 46 weeks of contract performance at 37.5 hours assuming 5 HQ SACT workdays per week between 0800 and 1700.
