The following questions were raised with respect to subject IFIB. Responses are to provide clarification.

Questions Responses NATO has a 38-hour work week, observes many HQ SACT Special Terms and Conditions, holidays, and typically closes over the winter Definitions: Man Year. 1800 hours of service to holiday period. Can you share the NATO ACT be rendered by one Contractor Personnel within observed holidays and break periods for one calendar year. The basis of this calculation is increased understanding of the NATO ACT work 46 weeks of contract performance at 37.5 hours assuming 5 HQ SACT work days per week. As a hour requirement per year? baseline the further assumption is: 15 days of HQ SACT holidays and 15 days as the minimum individual leave, thus allowing for the allocation of a minimum of 75 hours per year as possible overtime. As, in particular, the number of individual leave days may be greater and the number of HQ SACT holidays may vary, the allowable overtime figure will change accordingly. In no event shall the ceiling of 1800 hours per man year or corresponding fraction

thereof be exceeded.
