The score will be dependent upon the number of years and its relevance to ETEE FS Capability Management.

Can NATO please clarify if this requirement refers to bidders completing their own self- score within the proposal, as well as identifying where in the proposal demonstrated experience can be found? There is no minimum and no Pass / Fail. The score will be dependent upon the number of years and its relevance to ETEE FS Capability Management.
5. Is there a maximum page count associated with this proposal?
