

RFI: **RFI-ACT-SACT-22-130 - NATO Classified Cyber Range (NCCR)**

The following questions were raised with respect to subject RFI. Responses are to provide clarification.

Questions	Responses
1. Is there an incumbent contract. If so, can you share details regarding the size, scope, and identify the incumbent contractor.	1. There is no incumbent contract and no incumbent contractor. This is a RFI only, and not a RFP of any kind. HQ SACT has not made a commitment to procure any of the items described in the RFI herein, and release of this RFI shall not be construed as such a commitment, nor as authorization to incur cost for which reimbursement will be required or sought
2. The RFI document references "NCCR shall be capable of supporting 25 concurrent users", however in the Requirements Self-Assessment under CRA5-7.2 " The NCCR capability shall be able to train up to approximately 500 people simultaneously". Can you clarify the requirement please?	2. The NCCR shall be able to train up to approximately 500 people simultaneously, which might be split up into up to 25 teams. E.g. 25 teams (with 20 users each) are using the same scenario at the same time in parallel. The term users was misleading in this requirement.
