The following questions were raised with respect to subject **IFIB-ACT-SACT-24-28 NEXGEN M&S MULTI-DOMAIN OPERATIONS (MDO) COMMON SYNTHETIC ENVIRONMENT (CSE) DEMONSTRATION**. Responses are to provide clarification.

1. Whilst the requirement in the RFQ is clear, considering the intent to procure up to 8 demonstrations we thought we would at least offer the opportunity to offer an alternative demonstration. Would NATO be open to a proposal that demonstrates such a capability through this procurement event?	1. Companies are welcome to present their solutions. Federations (bringing together multiple simulation to “work” as one) is not what NATO is trying to do with NexGen. M&S NATO is looking for revolutionary changes not an evolutionary change. NexGen M&S is focused on the Common Synthetic environment, not a federation of simulations.
2. As a synthetic environment integrator, there is additional value (aligned to NATO ACT’s need) in including capabilities that facilitate the building, integration, merging and management of multiple federated SEs (as well as data, applications and analytics), as opposed to the singular use of one.	2.
