The following questions have been raised with respect to the subject RFI. Responses are provided for clarification.

Question	Response
Q1. Several of the questions in your RFI ask about investment and corporate systems capabilities that can support NATO wargaming, modelling, and simulation, as well as alluding to control and ownership rights. Is NATO only open to open-source platforms since they provide the best value and do not lock an organization into a specific vendor or developer, or is NATO open to contracting for a closed and proprietary software/architecture solution?	A1. We are looking to collect any information on existing solutions, which can include open-source platforms as well as closed and proprietary software/architecture solutions, to inform the Analysis of Alternatives (AoA) in support of the development of the AW Capability Programme Plan (CPP).
Q2. Could I please ask if you could clarify the following question with regard to RFI-ACT-SACT-24-67: 4.3.7. Response limited to a single main document and enclosures for a total not-to-exceed fifteen (15) pages (material provided as per paragraph above are not included in the total). The document should be single-spaced, have one-inch margins, assume US letter-size (8 1/2 by 11 inches) page, use 12-point font, and be formatted for compatibility with Microsoft Word or Adobe Acrobat Reader (current versions). By enclosures do you also include the 10 pages of Annex A or is the return of Annex A with answers included outside of the 15 page not-to-exceed total?	A2.
