Also, is there a limit to the number of contractors allowed on base? Can the government please clarify the funding terms for this project? Specifically, is the contractor responsible for purchasing all the listed materials and then reimbursed upon project completion? 	 A security clearance is not required to perform the work within the designated areas. There is currently not a limit on the number of contractor allowed on base, however it is the responsibility of the company to ensure contractors have base access through DBIDS. This is a Firm Fixed Price Contract, all costs (labour and materials) should be included and fully loaded in the proposal.

7. Is the contractor authorized to have building materials shipped directly from the manufacturer to the work site?	7. No. HQ SACT does not have a receiving warehouse or personnel to receive materials on site. Materials should be shipped from the manufacturer to the contractor facility and brought on site by contractor personnel.
