# TASK FORCE X



Task Force X is a multi-domain 360-degree approach that exploits emerging and disruptive technologies, including autonomous systems and artificial intelligence, in maritime operations.

The project employs autonomous systems to rapidly provide persistent surveillance, detect and track potential threats, and enhance the Alliance's situational awareness of sea lines of communication with the aim of safeguarding critical undersea infrastructure.

Task Force X's uncrewed vessels close critical intelligence gaps and free up expensive but limited crewed vessels to respond to urgent taskings.

The project showcases Allied Command Transformation's work to quickly adopt and integrate new technologies into defence capabilities across the Alliance, both in the NATO organization and in Allied militaries.

It is led by ACT in close collaboration with stakeholders from the Baltic nations, Allied Command Operations (Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe, Joint Force Command Brunssum, NATO Maritime Command, Commander Task Force Baltic), and other interested Allies such as the US Navy Task Force 66. Furthermore, Task Force X works closely with leading industry parties.
